As part of the PHSCE (Personal Health Safety and Citizenship Education) and the science curriculum areas, we will be delivering sex and relationship education to Y6 children. These lessons will take place from Tuesday, 23 June 2020. We will be teaching individual lessons that will cover:

- Changing bodies- puberty
- Emotional changes – how thoughts and feelings may change during puberty
- Understanding the influences around us that affect body image and the way that we see ourselves
- Relationships- understanding what a loving relationship is and the many types of relationships
- Sexual relationships
- Human reproduction
